POLICIES & PROCEDURES

REGISTRATION

Register in-person or online beginning 12/1.

Online registration does not include English as a Second Language (ESL) classes, high school diploma/GED programs, and select Career Technical Education programs.

FEES & ADMISSION

English as a Second Language, Citizenship Preparation, Adult Basic Education, High School Diploma, and GED Preparation classes are free. Fees for classes in other programs vary according to length and/or type of class. Some classes require the purchase of books or materials. Classes are primarily for adults 18 years or older. You do not have to live in San Leandro to attend. All teachers are credentialed or experts in their fields.

REFUNDS & RETURNED CHECKS

No refund of any fees unless a class is canceled. No transfer of fees. No exceptions to this policy. Please select classes carefully. Students will be required to pay for any bank fees associated with returned checks and credit card charges before being allowed to re-enroll in classes on a CASH ONLY basis.

ATTENDANCE

It is expected that students will attend all sessions. Missing one week of classes is cause for being dropped. **A minimum 20 hours of attendance is required before verification of attendance. (see page 1 for no-class dates.)**

COMMUNITY INTEREST & MOST OLDER ADULT CLASSES

Classes are self-supporting and taught by experts in their fields. Please do not wait to register. Classes will be shortened or canceled if there are not enough students.

VISITORS

All visitors must check-in at the main office with a government issued photo ID.

CREDIT RECOVERY STUDENTS

Full-time students from San Leandro High School, San Leandro Virtual Academy, and Lincoln High School will be allowed to enroll in classes. Juniors and seniors interested in pursuing this option must email their completed and signed **"Permit For Credit Recovery Enrollment 2025-26"** form with current transcript to the Credit Recovery instructor: aellerman@slusd.us. No out of district credit recovery students accepted. Credit Recovery students must be on time and remain in class and not leave early.

TRANSCRIPT POLICY

Transcript requests must be made in writing with original signature. San Leandro Adult & Career Education Center only issues transcripts from our institution. Requests may take up to three business days to process. Must present current government issued photo ID, for example, passport, driver's license, or state I.D. card to pick up transcripts. **We do not photocopy or return transcripts from other schools.**

PRIVACY RESTRICTIONS

Federal law (20 U.S.C.S. § 1232g(b)) prevents us from sharing student information without the written consent of the student. This means that the adult school cannot give other individuals information about what class, if any, a student attends, or if the student is present at school. Schools that fail to comply with this law risk losing federal funding.

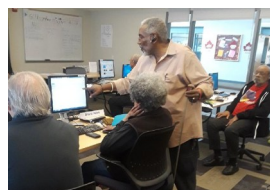

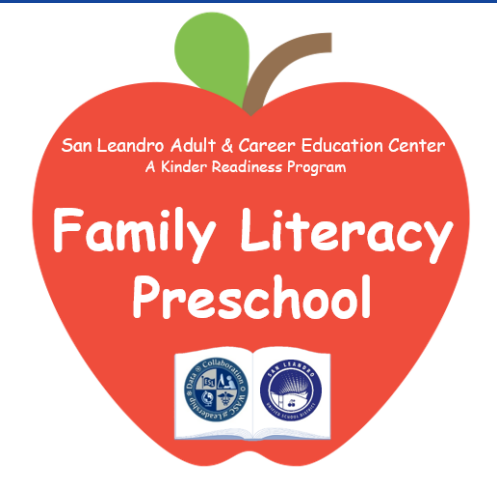

Tot Time is a weekly class for active and inquisitive two-year-olds and their parents or other caregivers. Taught by one of Broadmoor’s Directors, Kacia Sato. Each week, children are invited to engage in age-appropriate games and art projects, explore science and math concepts, and develop gross motor skills in free play outside. They also participate in singing, dancing, storytelling, and fingerplay at Circle Time as well as sharing a snack together. 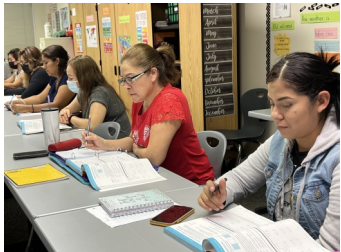
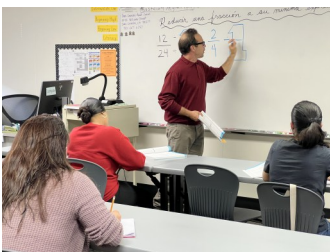
