CELDT Testing: We are currently testing EL students in Rm. 22. She also explained what CELDT testing is for those who were new to the group. The **California English Language Development Test**, or **CELDT**, has been administered since 2001 as a formal assessment of where a student's proficiency of English standards. The **CELDT tests** students who are English learners in the following areas: listening, speaking, reading and writing. Elisa Alvarez (principal) mentioned that the scores for the exam wouldn't arrive till May/ June so if they have any questions in the meantime they can ask her. She also explained that when their student reaches the desired score then that student will be up for reclassification.

Reclassification: Maria Ochoa (Parent Facilitator) talks to group about the process for reclassification and explains how CELDT scores play a big role in the process.

Elisa Alvarez (Principal) gives table opportunity for open discussion, suggestions, questions or concerns.

Elisa Alvarez our principal and Maria Ochoa parent facilitator welcome all ELAC attendees, Members and guest start signing in.

Maria Ochoa (Parent Facilitator) reviews agenda with the group.

Elisa Alvarez principal starts speaking about our first agenda topic which is school attendance and preparing students for SBAC.

- Washington students need to be on time and attend more school. Our attendance at this moment is not bad but could be better. Elisa encourages guest to speak with students about importance of attending school and being on time.
- Elisa Alvarez principal then starts touching base on SBAC testing. She informs guest how important it is for their students to truly respond to the best of their knowledge because these tests are very important to see if their students are progressing. She speaks of online programs such as compass learning which can provide extra support for students. Elisa notifies group she will print their individual students score sheet for SBAC for parent to view. The group then asks how they can access these programs.

Maria Ochoa Parent facilitator explained they can access these programs by entering our school website slusd.us/Washington and click on the student tab and drop down menu will appear select compass learning and enter students name, first initial of last name, and students ID number. Password is student's birthday. Elisa comes back in the room with copies of score sheets and hands out to parents. Parents start viewing their student's results.

Livier Lizarraga (guest) asks why is it that her student received a higher score the previous time and has now gone down.

- Elisa Alvarez (principal) responds going back to what she had previously mentioned it is important parents talk to their student about responding to the best of their knowledge. Also she will be working close with teachers on what is being taught and how we can support these students to progress.

Carmen Valtierra asked if there was something in place to provide 2nd and 3rd grade students with extra math support.

- Elisa Alvarez (principal) notifies group that the afterschool math intervention classes have begun as of yesterday 11/08/16 for students in grades 2-3. In about 8 weeks the math intervention

classes for 4th and 5th will commence. Students in these classes have to be referred by teachers to attend. But reminds group that students should use compass learning for extra support at home.

Group has no further questions.

Maria Ochoa Parent facilitator then started to talk about the next topic on the agenda which is the DELAC Meeting review.

- At the DELAC meeting we viewed the CAASP results for SLUSD. Washington's CASSP results were at a 4% last year and went up to a 6% this year. Group was very excited to hear this news.
- Also mentioned that at the DELAC meeting they learned CELDT testing will be changing next year.

Margarita Muñoz (ELAC Rep) and Cristina Frias (DELAC Rep) Notifies group of open positions at DELAC and how the results would be known at the next DELAC meeting which will be 11/10/16. Margarita then asks parents if there are any questions or concerns that they would like to bring up to DELAC.

Introduction of the Dual Immersion classes: Elisa Alvarez talked about the Dual Immersion classes that will be offered at Washington next school year. She explained the benefits of these classes which will bring together cultural backgrounds, help build community, level out number of students in class rooms, and also amp up academic achievement. She explained these classes will be offered to kinder students only next year and that class will lead the rest grades to come. Dual Immersion Teachers will receive support from District and also personnel here on campus, they will attend trainings and conferences to better understand and teach these classes. Cristina Frias and Margarita Muñoz add to the discussion of the Dual Immersion classes and explain to group what they learned at DELAC how these

classes are voluntary, how district approved to start at an 80:20 which means students will be learning 80% Spanish and 20% English of the time in class, eventually by the time students get to 5th Gr it will be at a 50:50. If programs are successful students will be promoted from fifth grade knowing two languages. State of the District: Margarita Muñoz and Maria Ochoa presented the state of the district hand out to the group and referenced to the set 5 of the 3 year goals. They both relay to the group what was presented at DELAC by Deputy Superintendent Rosanna Mucetti who explained the accomplishment of these goals and now what steps will be taken for the future. All parents will receive and updated booklet in the mail.

V. **Question and Answers:**

Guest had question how would students be supported if they are really struggling in the dual immersion class. Elisa Alvarez explained all methods of support that would be available to all parents, students, and teachers and explained how it is a process but eventually as time goes by things will progress.
