

The LCAP PAC (Parent Advisory Council) met February 24th via Zoom.

The meeting began at 6:00 pm and twenty-six parents participated in this meeting.

Local Control & Accountability Plan (LCAP) - Dr. Sonal Patel, Assistant Superintendent, Ed. Services

- Goal of meeting is to explain the purpose of the LCAP and have parents understand the budget (LCFF)
- Breakout rooms were formed for parents to engage in their *why?*;" Why did parents decide to participate in this meeting?"
 - Parent discussion included wanting to be aware of what is going on in the school district, especially if your student has unique learning needs
 - To better support their students at home, especially during distance learning
 - Support students returning from distance learning and providing the support needed to help them navigate the adjustment process
- LCAP process lasts 3 years from 2021-2024
- A video was reviewed explaining the LCAP process
 - Parents were asked to view the video in terms of their *why*: "what is really important for me to know about this process?"
 - Upon reviewing the video parents provided input on who the LCAP is intended for
- During LCAP the school district needs to address [8 priorities](#) that measure the quality of an educational program
 - Parents were asked about which priority brought them to this meeting?
 - Answers included student achievement and family involvement to aid in student success
- Another video was shown highlighting the process and timeline of the LCAP
 - The LCAP needs to be updated annually and how essential community involvement is to address concerns and identify needs
- 4 key components of LCAP that will be addressed during these meetings:
 - Engagement via meeting, surveys
 - Goals
 - Expenditures
 - Progress
- Timeline
 - LCAP Process and Timeline (February)
 - Forum Data - suggest actions (February & March)
 - Review suggested actions and expenses (April & May)
 - Public hearing; revision; approval (June)

Local Control Funding Formula (LCFF) - Dr. Kevin Collins, Assistant Superintendent, Business Svcs.

- Brief summary on how district funds are utilized highlighting the following areas:
- School District Finances
- Brief Economic Overview
- State Budget Overview
- Federal and State COVID-19 Funding
- After the presentation parents were asked "what are you hoping to see in education or your students in 2021-22?"

Parents provided input on what they learned from this meeting:

- Percentage of unduplicated students in the district
- How district funds are utilized
- Impact of state funding/economy/revenue on district funding
