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Política 5131: Conducta

La Mesa Directiva cree que todos los estudiantes tienen derecho a ser educados en un ambiente de aprendizaje positivo libre de interrupciones. Se espera que los estudiantes exhiban una conducta apropiada que no infrinja los derechos de otros ni interfiera con el programa escolar mientras se encuentren en los terrenos de la escuela, vayan o vengan de la escuela, en las actividades escolares o utilicen el transporte del distrito.

El superintendente o la persona designada se asegurará de que cada escuela desarrolle estándares de conducta y disciplina consistentes con las políticas de la Junta y los reglamentos administrativos. Los estudiantes y los padres / tutores serán notificados de las reglas del distrito y de la escuela relacionadas con la conducta.

La conducta estudiantil prohibida incluye, pero no se limita a:

1. Conducta que pone en peligro a los estudiantes, el personal u otros, que incluyen, entre otros, violencia física, posesión de un arma de fuego u otra arma y amenazas terroristas.

Discriminación, acoso, intimidación o acoso de estudiantes o personal, incluido el acoso sexual, comportamiento motivado por el odio, acoso cibernético, novatadas o actividad de iniciación, extorsión o cualquier otra conducta verbal, escrita o física que cause o amenace con causar violencia, daño corporal o alteración sustancial

3. Conducta que interrumpe el orden del aula o el ambiente escolar.

The district shall not be responsible for students' personal belongings which are brought on campus or to a school activity and are lost, stolen, or damaged.

6. Obscene acts or use of profane, vulgar, or abusive language

7. Possession, use, or being under the influence of tobacco, alcohol, or other prohibited drugs

8. Possession or use of a laser pointer, unless for a valid instructional or other school-related purpose (Penal Code 417.27)

Prior to bringing a laser pointer on school premises for a valid instructional or school-related purpose, a student shall obtain permission from the principal or designee.

9. Use of a cellular/digital telephone, pager, or other mobile communications device during instructional time

Such devices shall be turned off in class, except when being used for a valid instructional or other school-related purpose as determined by the teacher or other district employee, and at any other time directed by a district employee. Any device with camera, video, or voice recording function shall not be used in any manner which infringes on the privacy rights of any other person.

No student shall be prohibited from possessing or using an electronic signaling device

that is determined by a licensed physician or surgeon to be essential for the student's health and the use of which is limited to purposes related to the student's health. (Education Code 48901.5)

Employees are expected to provide appropriate supervision to enforce standards of conduct and, if they observe or receive a report of a violation of these standards, to immediately intervene or call for assistance. If an employee believes a matter has not been resolved, he/she shall refer the matter to his/her supervisor or an administrator for further investigation.

When a school official suspects that a search of a student or his/her belongings will turn up evidence of the student's violation of the law or school rules, such a search shall be conducted in accordance with BP/AR 5145.12 - Search and Seizure.

When a student uses any prohibited device, or uses a permitted device in any unethical or illegal activity, a district employee may confiscate the device. The employee shall store the item in a secure manner until an appropriate time.

Students who violate district or school rules and regulations may be subject to discipline including, but not limited to, suspension, expulsion, transfer to alternative programs, referral to a student success team or counseling services, or denial of participation in extracurricular or cocurricular activities or other privileges in accordance with Board policy and administrative regulation. The Superintendent or designee shall notify local law enforcement as appropriate.
