

The LCAP PAC (Parent Advisory Council) met on March 9th via Zoom.
The meeting began at 6:00 pm and 17 parents participated in this meeting.

Dr. Patel welcomed all parents to the meeting and recapped what the LCAP is.
Presentation slides containing LCAP data were continually uploaded in the Zoom chat for parents to review.
She stated parents would be reviewing student performance data and student survey data in this meeting.

In April, families will review family surveys and requests from DELAC as well as get a funding update from Dr. Collins.

In May, families will see how all the data looks in the LCAP budget.

Virtual breakout rooms (with translation) were formed for parents to discuss the performance data and student survey data in smaller groups for the duration of the meeting.

The parents reviewed the data provided below in the breakout rooms:

- Achievement data for K-5th grades for reading and math
 - Broken down by grades K-1 and 2-5
- Achievement data for 6-8 grades for reading and math
- Achievement data for 9-12 grades for reading and math
- Graduation Rate by Student Group: Class of 2021
- English Learner Classification Rate
- Student Survey Data
 - Elementary - 5th grade
 - Secondary - 6-12 grade

The parent discussions provided engaging input and concern about the percentages and data provided.
Parents made suggestions for actions based on what has already been in place from LCAP midyear updates and what may be needed.

Notes were compiled from each breakout group to capture all parent input.
