  - Independent Study
  - EL Paraeducator support and EL teacher Specialists
  - Intervention Specialists for grades TK-5
  - Curriculum (Science, History, Math)
- **Business Services**
  - COVID-19
    - Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) Review
    - Custodial Services at School Sites
- **Administrative Services**
  - Expanded learning after school (ASES) to sites that don't normally receive it
  - COVID-19 Testing Services
  - Supplemental Staffing
- **Educational Services**
  - Prevention and Intervention Programs
    - Intervention counselors at each secondary school
    - Additional counselors for mental health and therapy
    - Expanded socio-emotional learning contracts
