

## SAN LEANDRO UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT: MEASURE I SENIOR CITIZEN EXEMPTION INFORMATION FOR TAX YEAR 2024-25 For Owner-Occupants <u>Aged 65 as of June 30, 2024</u>

## NOTICE TO ELIGIBLE HOMEOWNERS AGED 65 OR OLDER AS OF JUNE 30, 2024:

Under the provisions of the Measure I Parcel Tax approved by the voters on November 6, 2018, homeowners age 65 or older by June 30, 2024, or for each year where the homeowner is age 65 or older by June 1 of that year, may request an exemption from the parcel tax.

## How to Apply for the Measure I Senior Citizen Exemption

- Applications are available electronically, by email, by request, or in person:

- Complete the Measure I Senior Citizen Exemption Application and include all of the following documentation (*copies only of each*):
  - Proof of ownership (2023-2024 property tax bill)
  - Proof of residence (electric or cable bill)
  - Proof of birth date (driver's license, birth certificate, or passport)
- Completed applications and required documents are due by June 30, 2024

Once your exemption is approved, the exemption will be automatically renewed if you continue to own and occupy the same residence.

If you change ownership or purchase a different home within the district, you must re-file for a Senior Citizen exemption for the new property.



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As a senior citizen and property owner, you may request to be exempt from Measure I. Once your exemption is approved, the exemption will be automatically renewed as long as you continue to own and occupy the residence. If you sell your home and purchase a different home in the school district, you must re-file for a Senior Citizen Exemption for the new property.

To request the exemption, please complete and return the application and proof of ownership, residence, and age by <u>June 30, 2024</u>, to <u>one</u> of the following:
