

Local Control Accountability Plan Parent Advisory Committee Reunion Meeting Notes

The LCAP PAC (Parent Advisory Committee) met October 16th at the San Leandro Unified School District boardroom.

The meeting began at 6:00 p.m. and there were 14 members present.

1. Welcome and Introductions

- Dr. Patel welcomed the PAC members and thanked them for their participation in last year's LCAP input.
- Dr. Patel introduced staff that were in attendance. Staff in attendance were Joanne Clark, Aaron Kerigan, Dr. Keziah Moss, Dr. Sonal Patel, and Dr. Thom Reinhardt.
- Dr. Patel asked the PAC to introduce themselves and share their child's school and what their favorite subject was in school.

2. Back to School Reflections and Observations - Table Talk Discussions

- PAC members at each table briefly discussed what they have observed this school year at their respective schools that connects to the district's LCAP goals or goals in other Federal or State funded programs.
- Each table then shared with the whole group what has been observed.

3. Projects underway related to LCAP Goals

 Dr. Patel and Dr. Moss reviewed various projects that are underway, which includes Pathways to Inclusion, dual enrollment for college and career readiness, discipline and school climate, teacher evaluation system, school based behavioral health and report cards and assessments.

4. Strategic Plan for 2025-2028

- Dr. Patel and Dr. Moss shared the district's new strategic plan, which includes the following four goals.
 - Goal #1: Deep Learning for Real-World Readiness
 - Goal #2: Prioritize Student Health and Belonging
 - Goal #3: Strong, Connected Partnerships
 - Goal #4: Improved Infrastructure for Safety and Environmental Equity.
